### ITEM LIST FOR BOARDING

#### **All personal items MUST be named correctly and clearly with printed name tags.**

---

- Clothing suitable for special occasions
- Tidy casual clothing to wear around Hostel
- 1 x pair of slippers / jandals
- Minimum 7 pair of underwear
- White thermal top to be worn under uniform (optional for winter)
- White/nude bras to be worn under uniform blouse (compulsory for summer)
- Umbrella and raincoat
- Sports shoes
- 1 x dressing gown
- 2 x pairs of pyjamas
- Warm jersey/polar fleece/sweatshirt
- Toilet bag and personal toiletries – including sunscreen and nail polish remover
- Linen bag/basket for soiled clothes
- Laundry powder in a sealed container
- Swimming togs
- Clothes hangers
- School bag, lunch box & water bottle
- Airtight container to store extra cereal or biscuits
- Extra name tapes and fabric marking pen
- Sunhat
- Full school uniform with Roman sandals for summer and regulation black shoes for winter, more than 1 blouse is required
- Laptop for school and Prep – check the HGHS website for equipment specifications

**NOTE:** Please sew name tapes on **all personal items** including clothing, bedding, towels and also write name or hostel number inside pockets or on hems as a back-up in case the name tape is removed. Remember to name bags also.

#### **Linen to be provided by the student:**

---

- 2 x pairs of sheets (fitted bottom sheet is best)
- Pillow(s)
- 3 x towels
- 2 x pillowslips
- 1 x duvet and extra blanket for winter

**Remember** to mark any sports equipment, footwear, computer, cell phone, iPad etc., (an engraver is available at Hostel for wood, plastic and synthetic surfaces). Please do not bring in unnecessary items, especially jewellery, electronics, money or items of sentimental values.

During the year please check that any new items purchased are named. Also please check your daughter's bags when she is at home. If another student's items have been mixed in with your daughter's gear please contact a Boarding Manager or contact the owner directly. We expect Hostel girls to respect each other and other peoples' property. Please reinforce personal values and the need for honesty and diligence in taking care of personal items. Please reiterate that theft is a crime and will result not only in consequences but the ongoing stigma of a bad reputation. Parental support is greatly appreciated.
